

Rocky Ridge Cemetery

Policies and Procedures

- Cemetery Committee
 - The sexton will be appointed by the town council.
 - This committee will be appointed by the town council.
 - This committee will be responsible for the Cemetery grounds.
 - There will be no digging in the cemetery without permission.
 - No Plants or Trees will be allowed to be planted within the cemetery without permission from this committee.
 - Items left at grave site will be cleared as needed by this committee.

- Plots
 - Plots will be purchased through the Town of Rocky Ridge.
 - A record of the purchase as well as the Interment will be filed by the Town.
 - A plot size equals four feet by eight feet.
 - An infant half lot is four feet by four feet, but is only to be sold as a whole plot.
 - A fee of \$350.00 to residents of the Town of Rocky Ridge for opening and closing the graves will be assessed, unless special arrangements are made by the Sexton.
 - A fee of \$500.00 to non residents of the Town of Rocky Ridge for opening and closing the graves will be assessed unless special arrangements are made by the Sexton.
 - Adult graves are approximately five to six feet deep.
 - Youth and Infant are approximately four to five feet deep.
 - An approved vault will be required for all burials.
 - Only one grave per plot or half lot, there is no double stacking grave.

- Headstones
 - All burial graves must have a headstone within one year of the Interment date.
 - A headstone may not exceed the plot dimensions.
 - Infant half lots will be required to have flat head stones.
 - All head stones should be placed in a cement base with four inches of cement on all sides.
 - It may be necessary for headstones to be removed when an adjacent grave is opened and closed. The headstone will then be replaced after the service.
